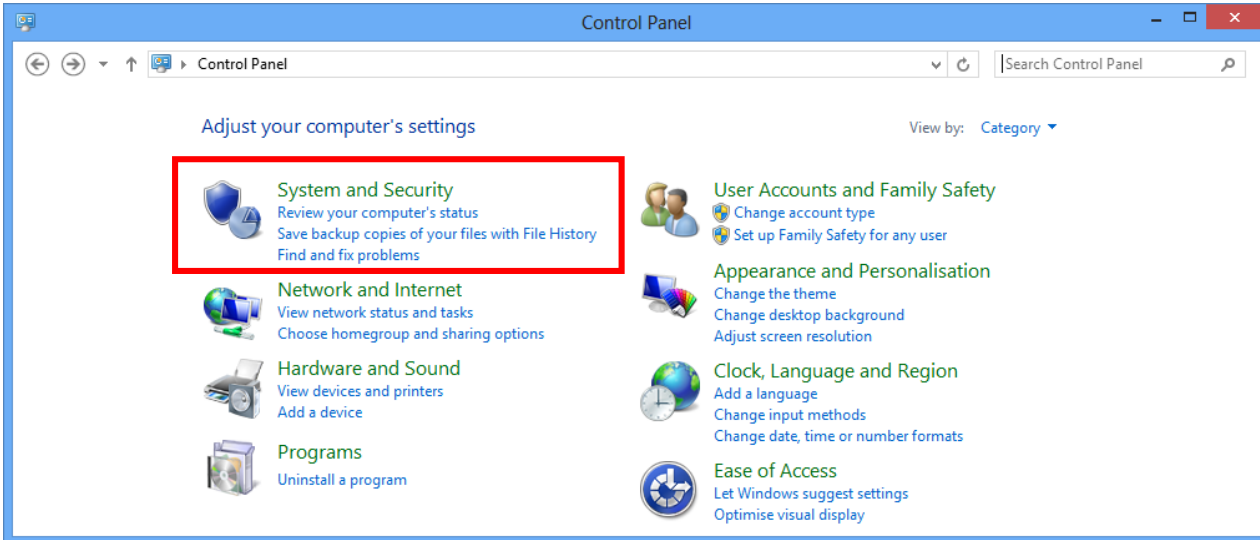


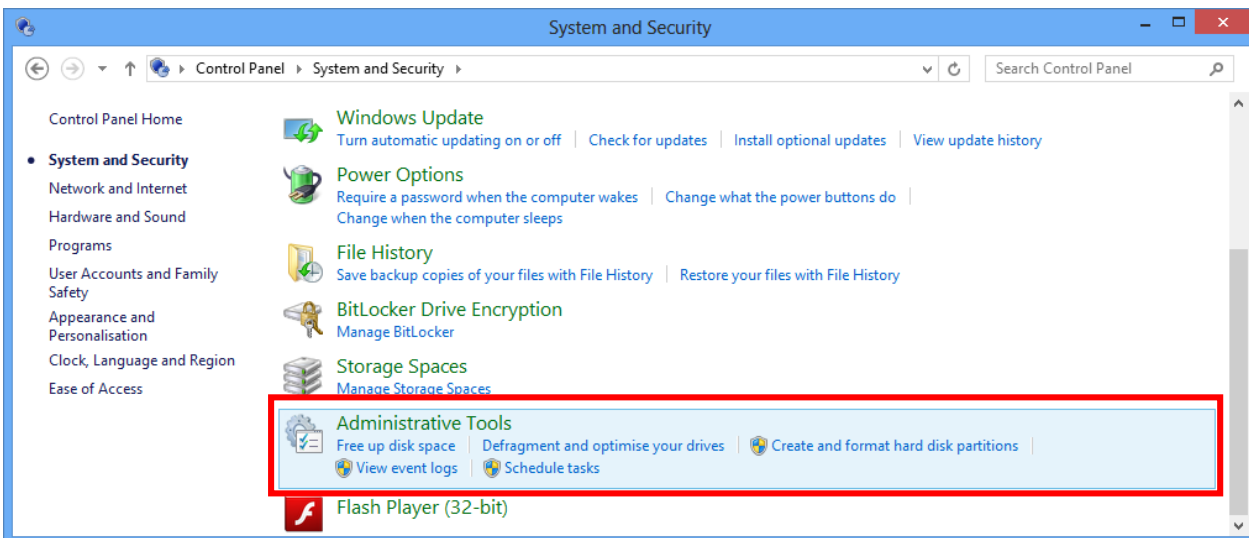

Wireless LAN settings for Windows 8

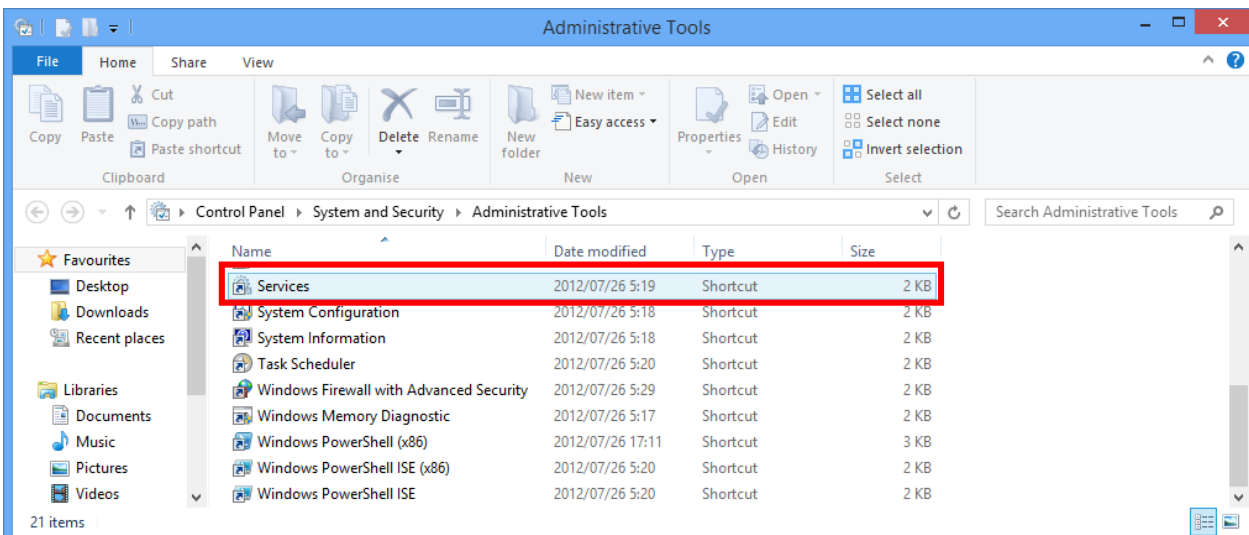
1. Go to **Control Panel** and double-click **System and Security**.



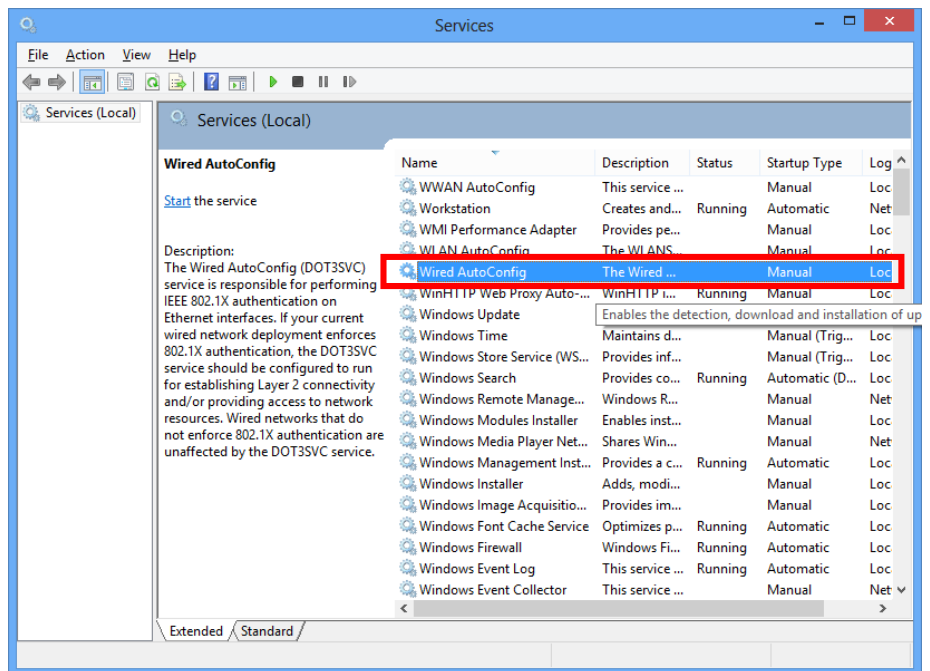
2. Click **Administrative Tools**.



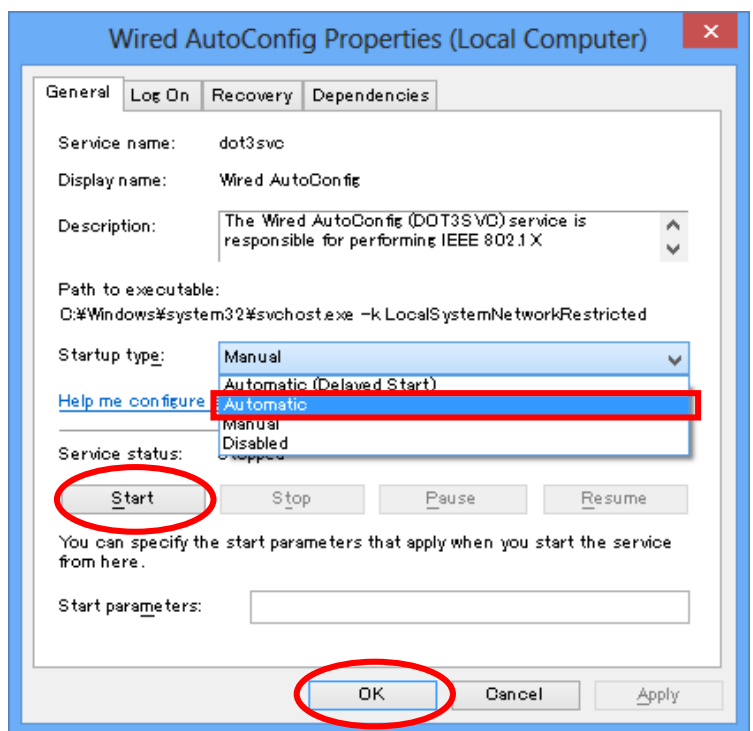
3. Double-Click **Services**.



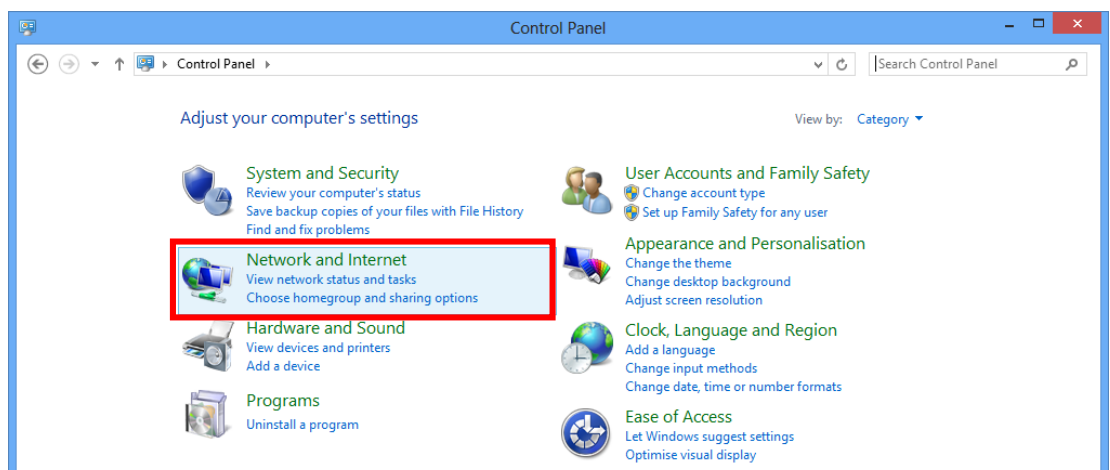
4. Double-Click Wired **AutoConfig**.



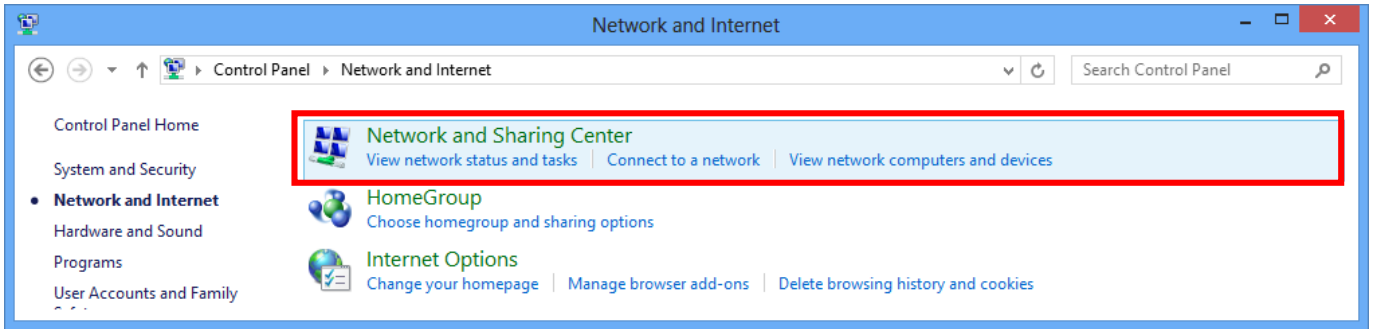
5. Select **Automatic** for **Startup type** first, and click **Start**. And click OK.



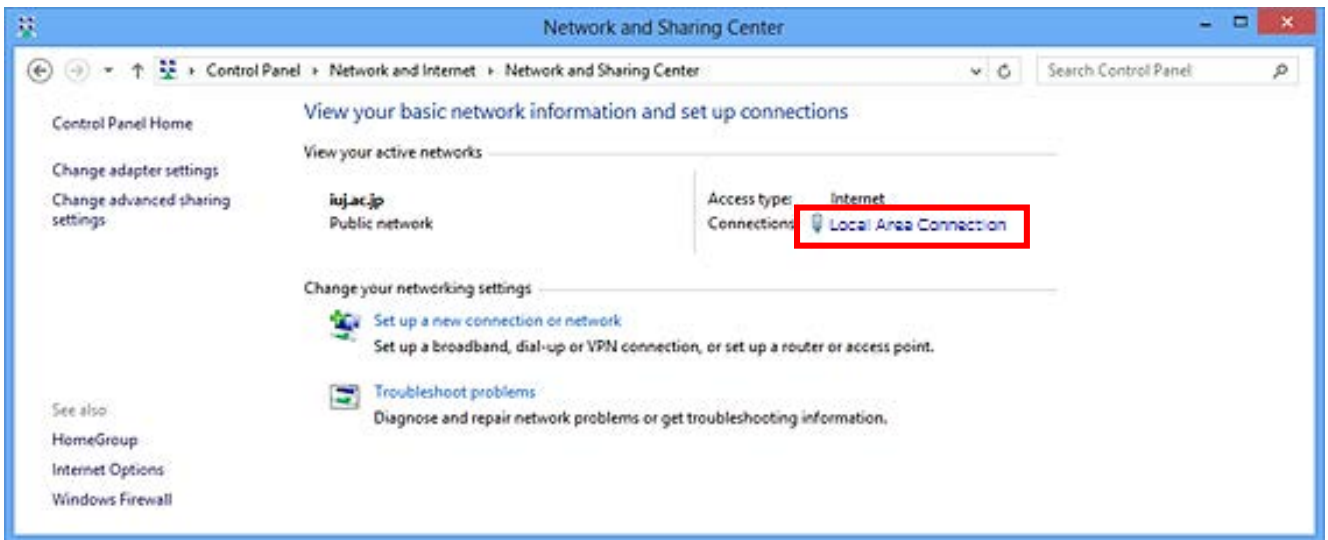
6. Go back to **Control Panel**, and double-click **Network and Internet**.



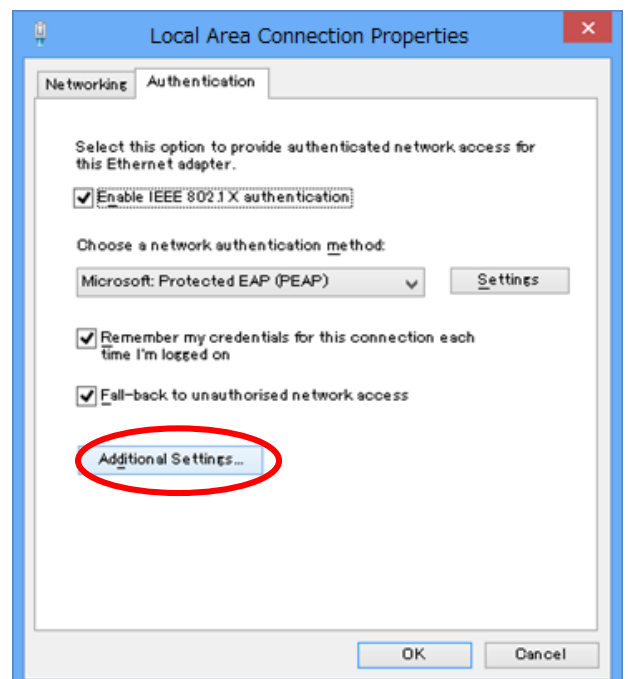
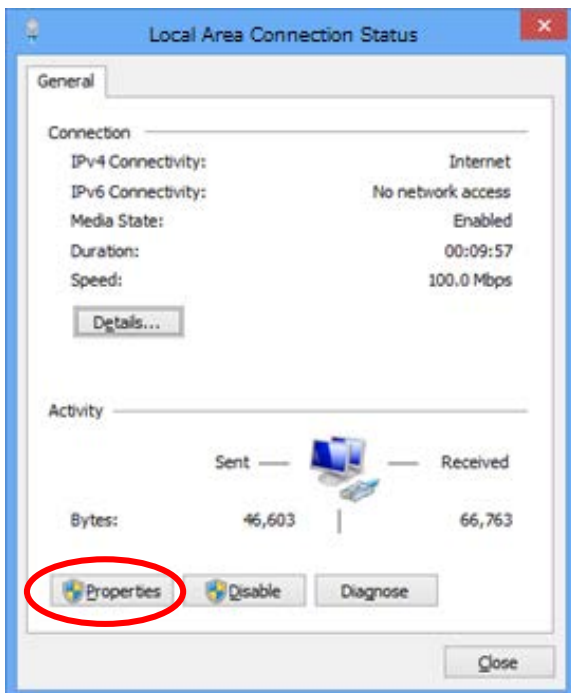
7. Click **Network and Sharing Center**.



8. Click **Local Area Connection**. (Assume a LAN cable is plugged to an outlet.)

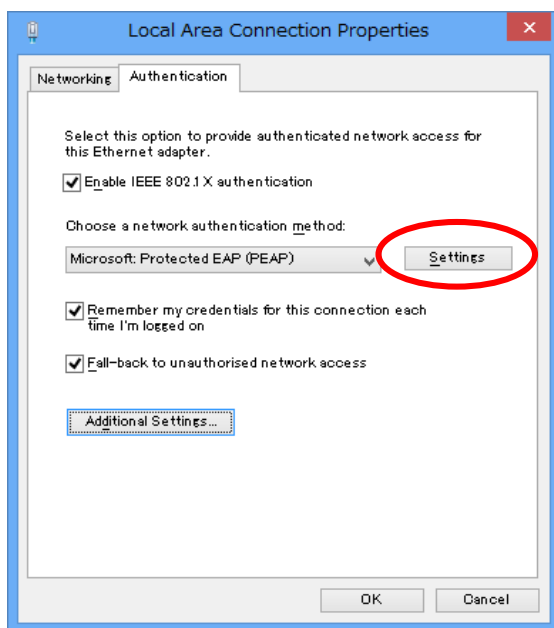
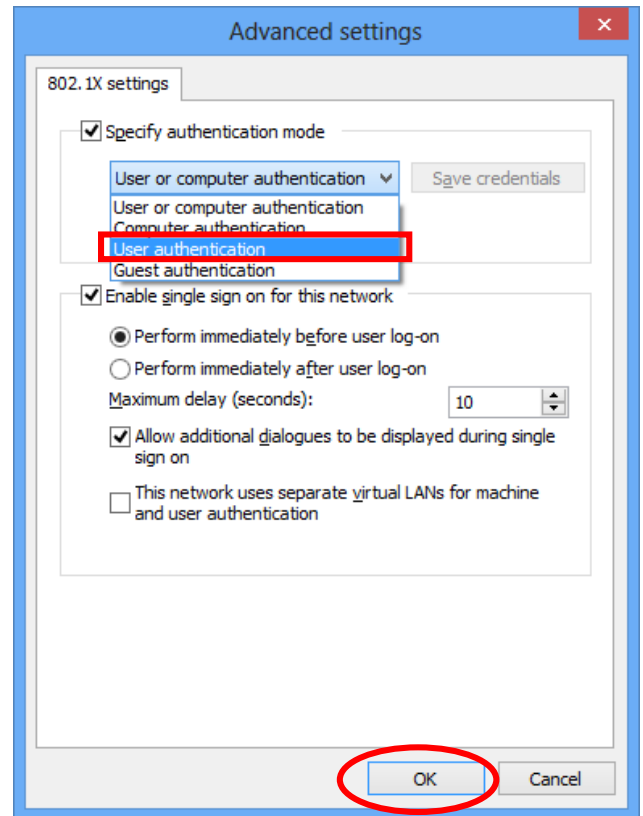


9. When the window on the left appears, click **Properties**.



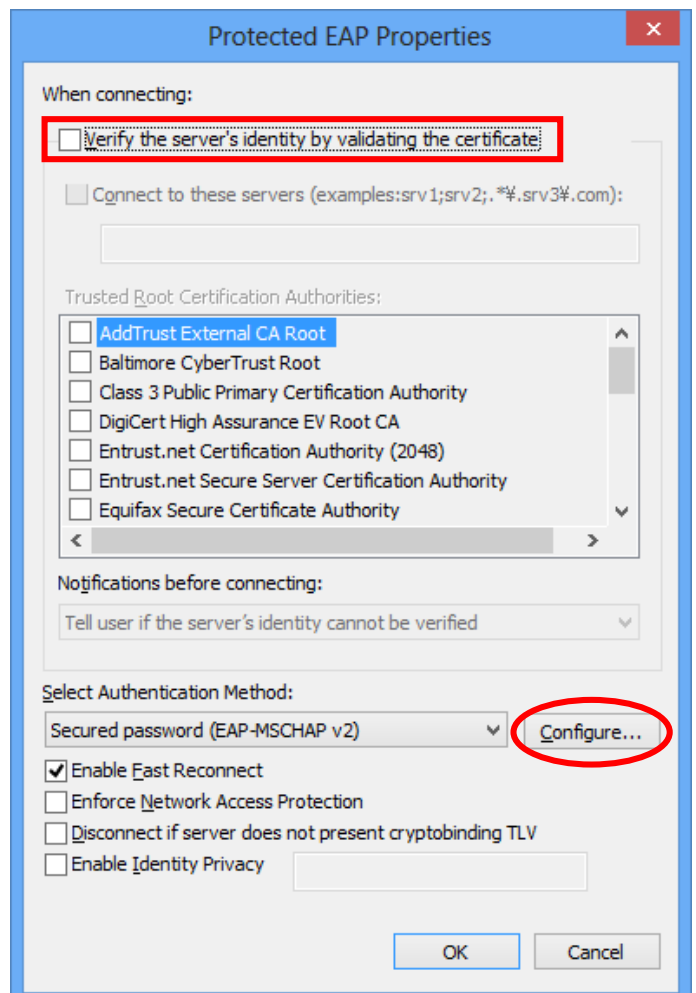
10. Select the **Authentication** tab, click **Additional Settings**.

11. On the 802.1X settings, check on **Specify authentication mode** and select **User authentication** from the pull down menu.
Also check on **Enable single sign on for this network** and then click OK.

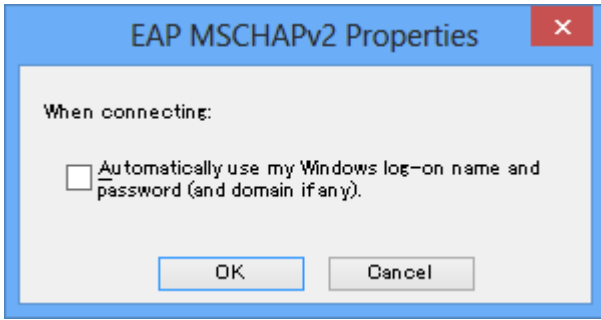


12. Go back to this window, click **Settings**.

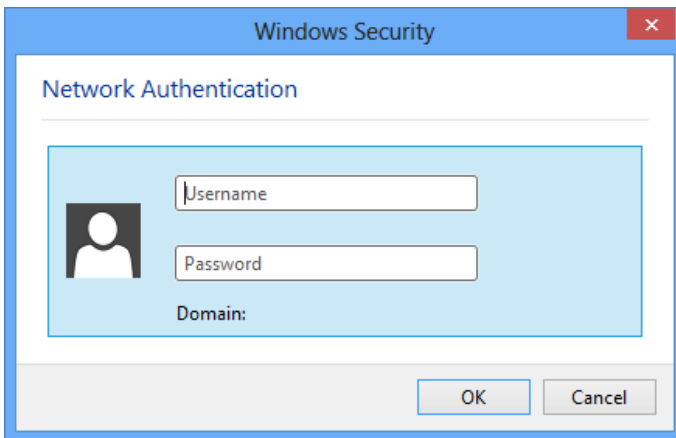
13. Uncheck **Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate** and click **Configure**.



14. Uncheck **Automatically use my Windows log-on name and password (and domain if any)**.



15. When the window below appears, enter **your own user name and password for IUJ** and click OK.



16. When the status is **Connected**, you have got connected to the IUJ network.
