Note 1) Students are required to take either "Financial Accounting" or "Financial Reporting". A screening test will be conducted to determine which course is suitable for you before the start of the Fall term.

Note 2) The required number of credits from Core Elective course differs depending on whether a thesis or research report is written. For the thesis option 10 credits must be obtained from Core Elective Courses, while 14 credits must be obtained in the case of a research report option.

Note 3) Students are required to obtain at least 30 credits from the courses listed in the GSIM course offerings other than language courses.
