

**Diploma Policy of Master of Social Entrepreneurship  
International Social Entrepreneurship Program (ISEP)**

In order to accomplish the objectives stipulated in the IUJ Graduate School Regulations, as well as the mission of GSIM, ISEP defines the degree requirements and learning goals & objectives which are necessary to Master of Social Entrepreneurship as follows:

**<Learning Goals and Objectives>**

The students aiming to obtain Maser of Social Entrepreneurship (MSE) are required to acquire following skills, knowledge and attitudes:

## **<Degree Requirements>**

### **Enrollment Requirements**

Students are required to enroll for a minimum of one year (three terms) for course work and additional period for field study on a degree candidate basis.

The standard period of study for ISEP is 1 year and 4 months to 3 years, depending on the period of field study.

### **Course/Credit Requirements**

Students are required to complete a necessary number of credits of core required courses, core elective courses, elective courses, and field study in accordance with the requirements designated by ISEP. The required number of credits for obtaining an MSE degree is at least 34 credits.

Credits will be given to students who have completed all activities related to the assessment specified in the course syllabus and have a final evaluation score of 60 points or above (out of 100), or the equivalent.

### **Field Study**

Research Report is required to obtain MSE degree. Expected content is the results of Field Study that mainly involves social business idea preparation and verification. The location of Field Study will be decided according to student's plan.

### **Research Report Requirements**

Students are required to complete and submit an acceptable Research Report on a specific theme under the guidance of supervisors.

### **Final Examination Requirements**

Students must pass the final examination, which is conducted according to the implementation method determined by the examining committee.

### **GPA Requirement**

Students are required to obtain a total GPA of at least 2.5 out of 4.0
