**Course Description:**

- Students will learn basic structures, vocabulary, and expressions of Japanese for the further development of the language to achieve the intermediate Japanese level at IUJ.
- Also, at the end of the Elementary Japanese III, the students will have learnt around 250 kanji, attained an equivalent to the N4 level of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test, and attained intermediate-low or Intermediate-mid level in the Oral Proficiency Interview test.

**Learning Objectives:**

- Elementary Japanese II students will be able to maintain simple and basic communication in Japanese.
- Elementary Japanese II students will be able to:
  - talk about something concrete and familiar to them.
  - say a simple opinion, compare more than two things/people, give advice and tell symptoms to a doctor.
  - give a short presentation using a script which is prepared in advance.
  - read and write around 70 kanji, which means they will know 150 kanji total including Elementary Japanese I.

**Active participation in class** is strongly recommended to attain these objectives.

- conversation practice with Japanese visitors
