"Workshop on the Effective Utilization of International Students and Other Foreign Personnel with the Goal of Overseas Deployment"

Against a backdrop of progressing globalization and a shortage of labor, securing and developing global personnel who are familiar with foreign languages, international business, and overseas business customs are becoming important issues for success in overseas business deployment. Even in Niigata Prefecture, the place of study for many international students, the number of corporations with a strong interest in the effective utilization of such foreign personnel is growing.

Therefore, under the Comprehensive Partnership Agreement formed in 2016, JETRO Niigata, the International University of Japan, and the Nagaoka University of Technology will hold a workshop for small and medium-sized corporations engaging in overseas deployment, with the themes of recruiting, developing, and entrenching international students and other human resources engaged in study within the prefecture.
