Guidelines for Writing a Research Proposal

The research proposal is central to your application to any program at the International University of Japan. Please read the following guidelines carefully to ensure that your statements include the information evaluators need to assess your application.

You should treat the proposal as an opportunity to show that you have an interest in an area of study and that you can identify a meaningful question in that area. You also demonstrate that you can express your ideas in clear and precise English. The evaluators who read your proposal know that it is a provisional statement and that your research questions may change during your research.

A research proposal demonstrates that you have a project both worth doing and manageable within the timescale of the degree you are applying. Your project must be well-founded and contribute to understanding in its field to be worth doing. To make sure that your project is manageable within your study period, you'd better narrow the scope of the research question. Usually, a specific or concrete question is desirable.

The following template will guide you through these things.

a) Title (Maximum 30 words)

Be as concise and explicit as you can.

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b) Introduction (Maximum 200 words)

Introduce the questions and issues central to your research. Identify the field of study in broad terms and explain how you expect your research to contribute to the specific business or academic domains.

- What are your research scope and the target(s) for investigation? (Countries, industries, organizations, or any other focus area for your research)
- What would you like to prove, clarify, or find out as a result of your research?

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c) Research background and questions (Maximum 400 words)

Here, please expand your Introduction. What are the key texts and arguments in the field, and how does your proposal differ from existing lines of argument? What does your project contribute to existing work in the area? How does it extend our understanding of particular questions or topics? You need to set out your research questions as clearly as possible, explain problems you want to explore and say why it is crucial. Add a *diagram* or a *table* highlighting your idea, if applicable.

- What did you learn so far about the existing lines or arguments related to your research topic?
- What are your initial hypotheses or conjectures about the outcomes?
- Which aspects of your research would be new and unique, as not just repetitions of past research?
- Why your research outcomes would be of high-value and impact, both for solving real-world problems and for the academic progress

d) Research methods (Maximum 200 words)

Describe how you would support your argument. You can use textual, historical, statistical, or visual analysis as long as it is relevant. You can also use a theoretical framework. And what sources will you use? The detail will depend very much on your research topic.

e) Bibliography

List the books and articles to which you refer in the proposal.
